### **CLINICAL SUPERVISION**

### **PRIVATE PRACTICE**

From 1988 to 1995 I was in private practice doing individual, couples and group therapy. I co-led a psychodrama group during this time, working primarily with adult trauma survivors.

From May 1999 I have been on the staff of Gerry Spence's Trial Lawyers College of Dubois, Wyoming. As such I work as a staff trainer with lawyers who attend the college to earn Continuing Legal Education units. Along with 3 other staff members, we teach use of self ethics, group information and dynamics as they apply to jury selection, action methods, and effective ways to help clients convey their stories in courtrooms.
